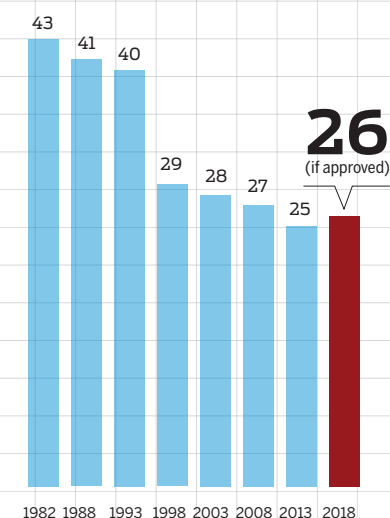


RESTRUCTURING ACROSS THE BOARD

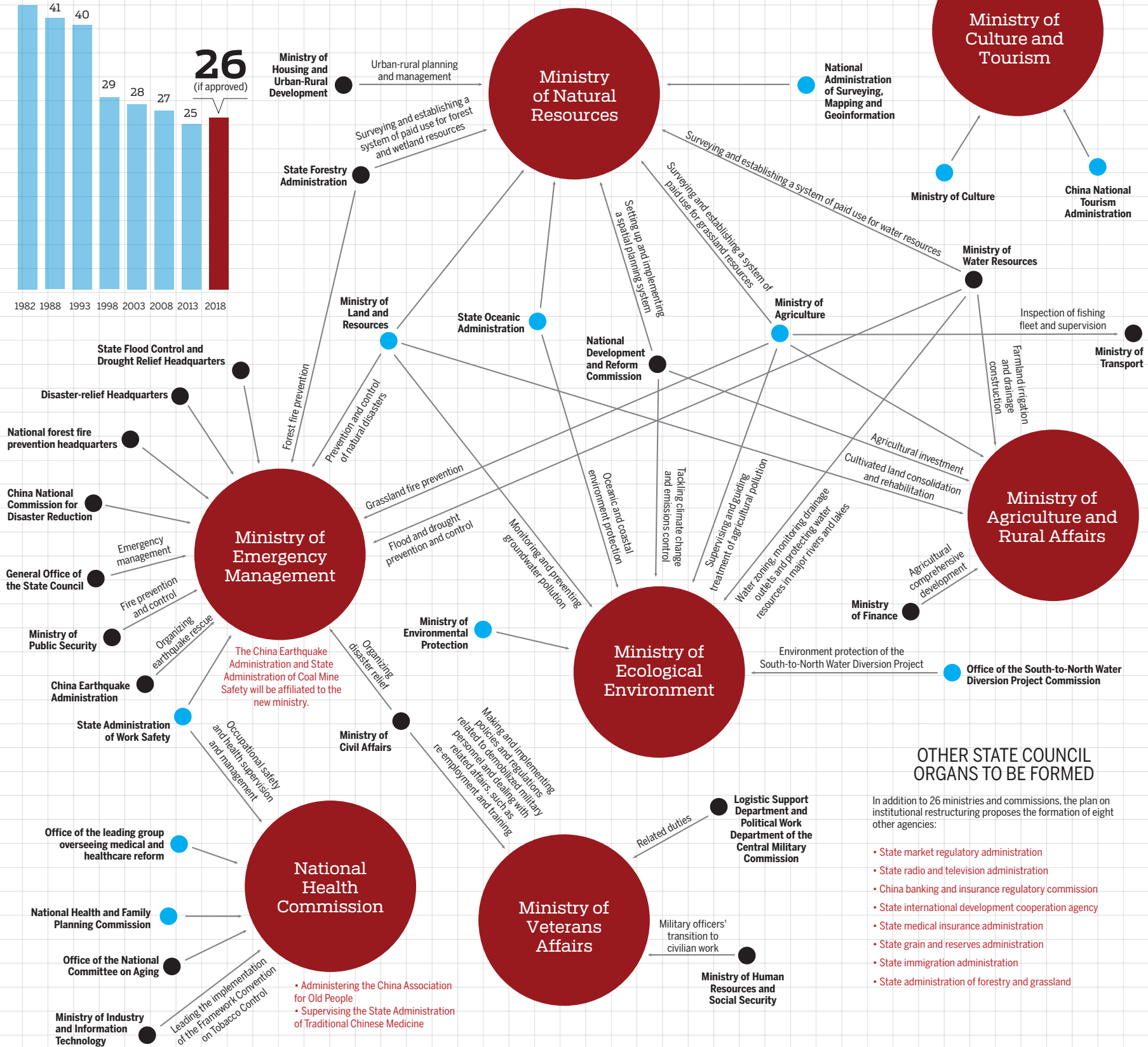


MINISTRIES AND COMMISSIONS

OTHER STATE COUNCIL ORGANS TO BE FORMED

- In addition to 26 ministries and commissions, the plan on institutional restructuring proposes the formation of eight other agencies:
- State market regulatory administration
 - State radio and television administration
 - China banking and insurance regulatory commission
 - State international development cooperation agency
 - State medical insurance administration
 - State grain and reserves administration
 - State immigration administration
 - State administration of forestry and grassland
